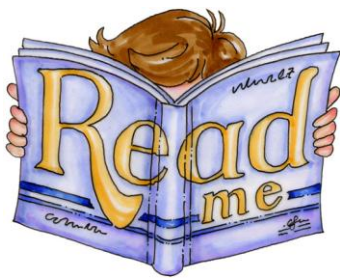
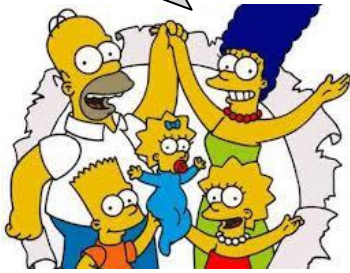
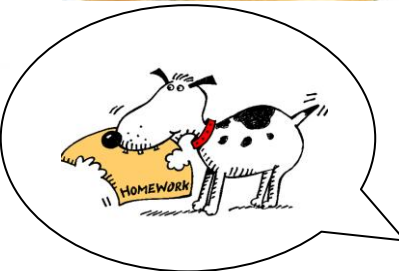


Do you want to be a superhero at English?
