

# Flying Carpets Battleships.

This game is played like traditional battleships.

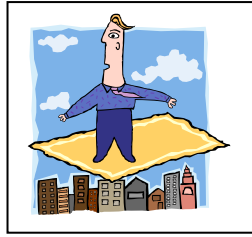
1. The game is played in pairs. Each player has a sheet. First they place their 1 flying carpet, 2 broomsticks and 2 flying doormats in the top grid, making sure their partner cannot see where they have placed them.
2. The players take turns to try to find their partner's flying carpet, broomsticks and flying doormats. They do this by choosing a square. For example, if they choose the square I have marked X, they have to make a sentence with **you** are the subject and using **do/does**. **Do you like apples? Where do you live?** But **You do the washing up** is also possible.
3. If this square does not contain a flying carpet, broomstick or flying doormat their partner says Miss. If this square contains a flying carpet, broomstick or flying doormat their partner says Hit or Hit and shot down if all the squares of the object have been found.

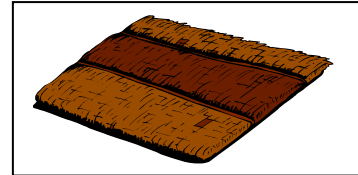
