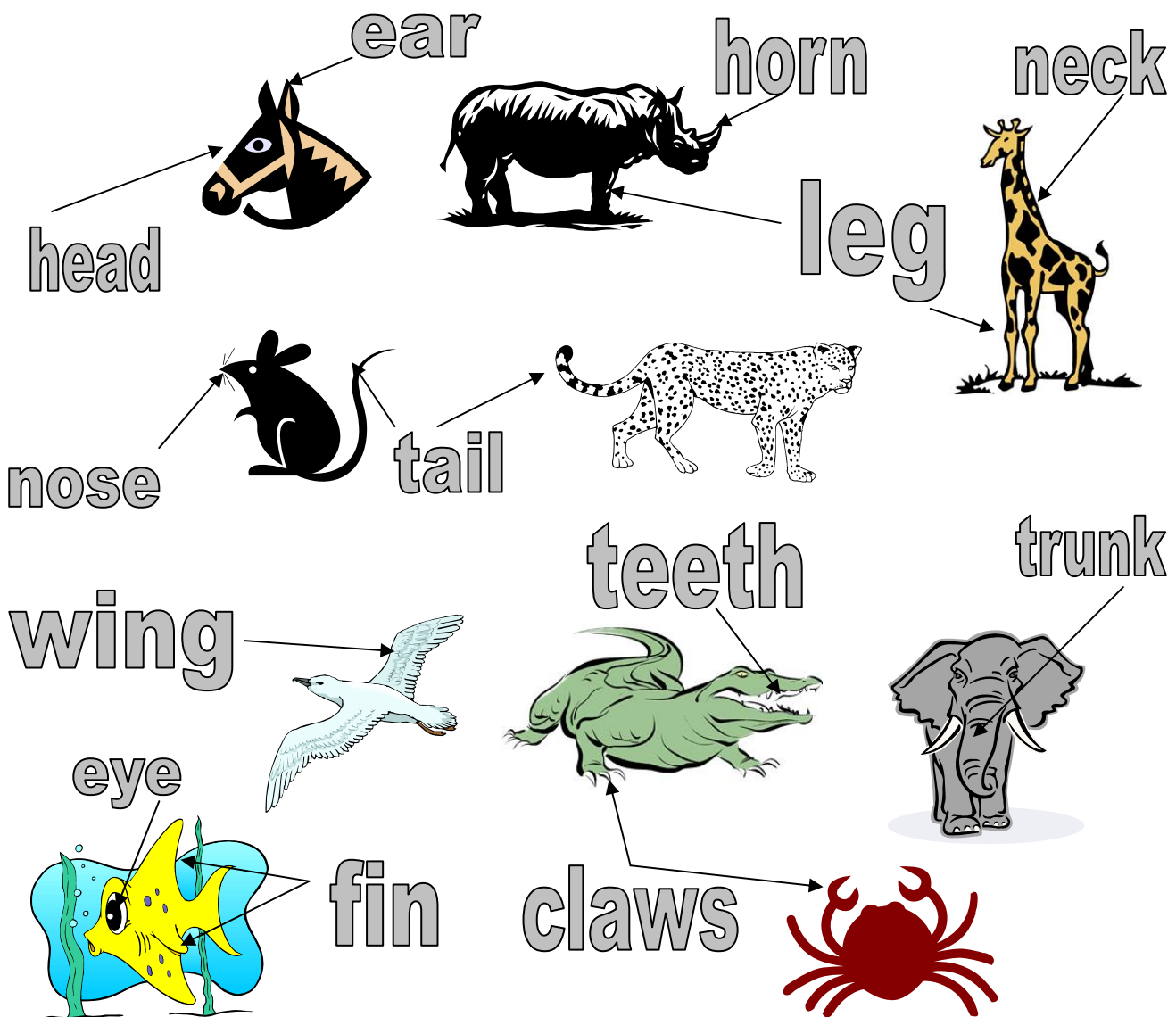


Parts of an animal

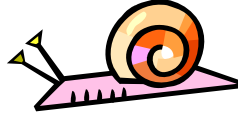

Shop assistant: Hello, can I help you?

Sam: Have you got a **big** elephant?

Shop assistant: Yes, I have. Here you are.

Sam: Have you got a **small** octopus?

Shop assistant: Yes, I have. Here you are.

Sam: Have you got a **long** snake?

Shop assistant: No, I haven't. I've got a **short** snake.

Sam: Have you got a **fast white** horse?

Shop assistant: Yes, I have. Here you are.

Sam: Have you got a **small green** octopus?

Shop assistant: No, I haven't. I've got a **small yellow** octopus.

Sam: Have you got a **dangerous** lion?

Shop assistant: No, I haven't. I've got a **dangerous** mouse.

Sam: **A dangerous** mouse?

Shop assistant: Yes, here you are.

Mouse: Hello, I am a mouse.

Sam: This mouse isn't **dangerous**!

Shop assistant: Yes, it is.

Mouse: Yes, I am.

Sam: *You (talking to the mouse) are not dangerous, you are a mouse!*

Mouse: Grrrrrrrrr!

Sam: Aaaaaaaaaaaaaahhhhhhhhhhhh

(exit pet shop running)

Shop assistant: A very **dangerous** mouse.
