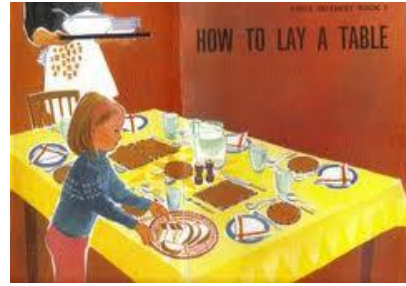


Are you a good boy or girl?

Santa's interview

Work with a partner. Read the dialogue, then swap roles and read it again. Try really acting!
